

Sol: During the same period, 1,246 periodicals were issued. These include 396 technical journals of which 36 were issued to member of class B, 45 to class D, and 315 to class E. To members of classes B, C, D and E the number of other journals issued were 419, 26, 231 and 99, respectively.

The report, however, showed an increase of 4.1 per cent in the number of books issued over last month, though there was a corresponding decrease of 6.1 per cent in the number of periodicals and journals issued to members.
