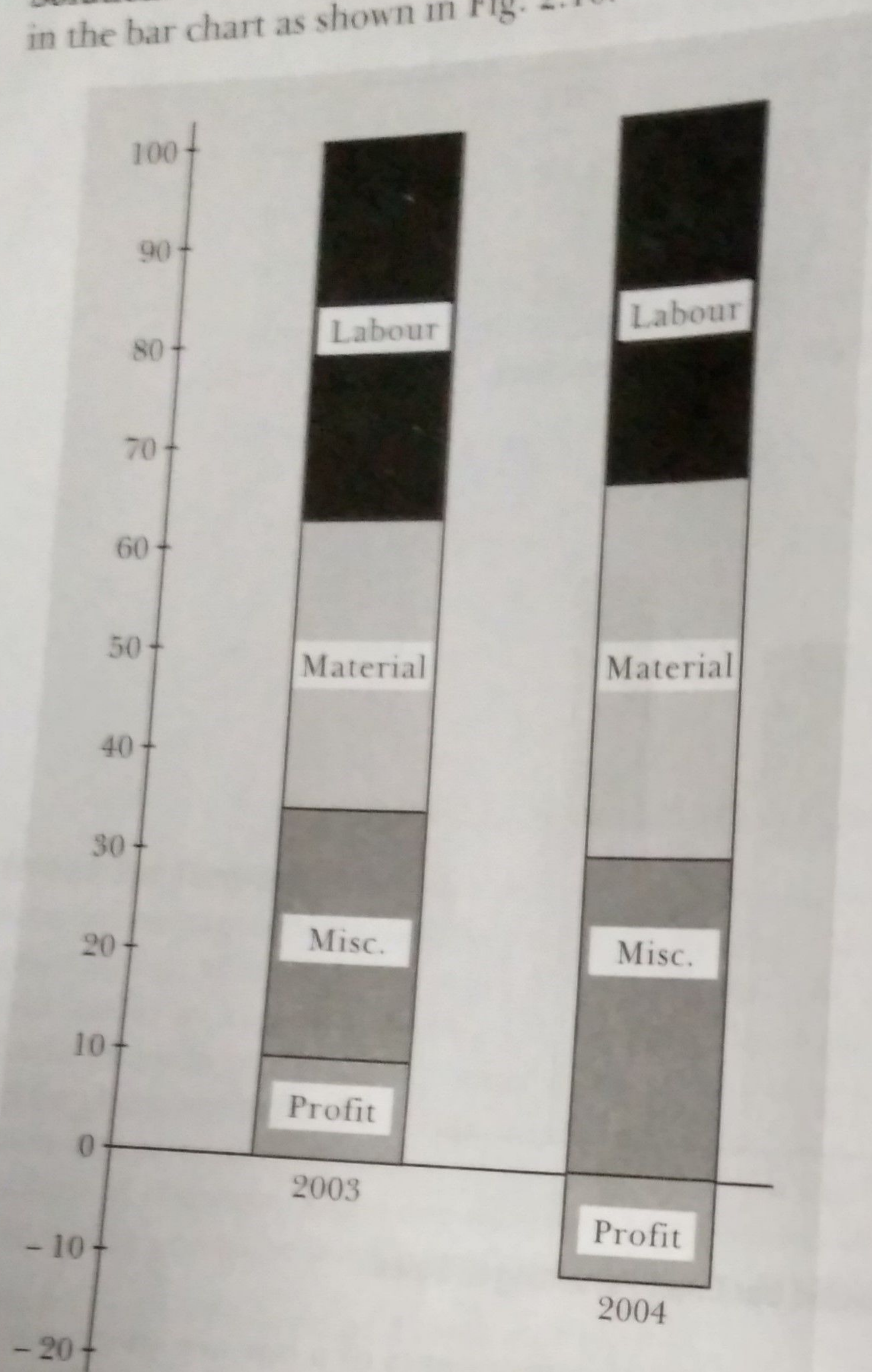


Solution: The cost, sales and profit/loss data expressed in terms of percentages have been represented in the bar chart as shown in Fig. 2.10.

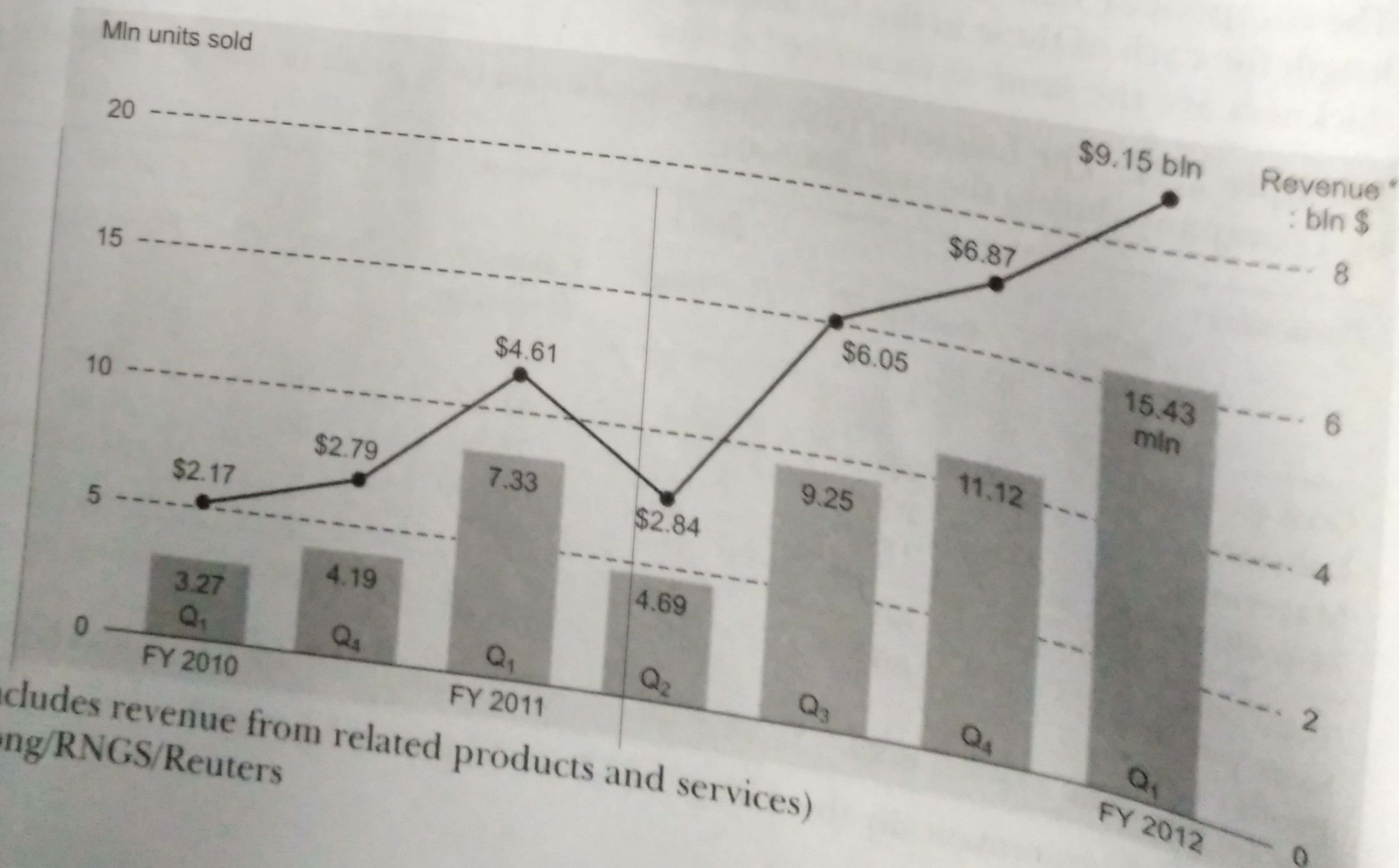


Frequency Polygon The frequency polygon is formed by marking the mid-point at the top of horizontal bars and then joining these dots by a series of straight lines. These are formed as a closed figure with the horizontal axis, therefore a series of straight lines are drawn from the mid-point of the top base of the first and the last rectangles to the mid-point falling on the horizontal axis of the next outlying interval with zero frequency.
