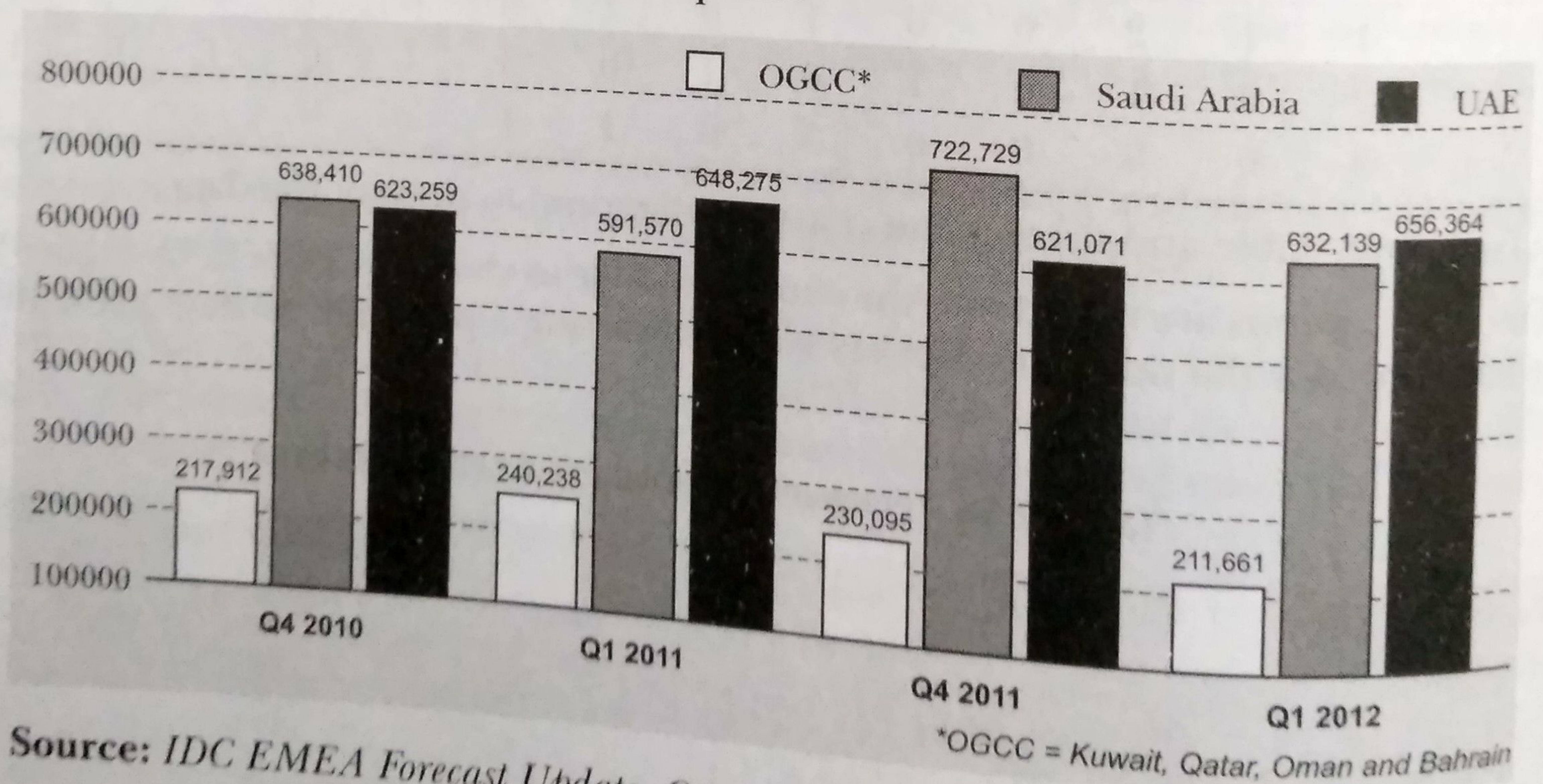


Figure 2.4: Number of Letters Received

Multiple Bar Diagrams A multiple bar diagram also known as grouped (or compound) bar diagram is useful for direct comparison between two or more sets of data. The technique to draw such a diagram is same as that of a single bar diagram with a difference that each set of data is represented in different shades or colours on the same scale. An index of shades or colours must be given along with diagram.
